Year 2000 Compliance

All hardware, software, or firmware in any products furnished under this order shall be Year 2000 compliant as delivered. Year 2000 compliant means information technology that accurately processes date/time data (including, but not limited to, calculating, comparing, and sequencing) from, into, and between the twentieth and twenty-first centuries, and the years 1999 and 2000 and leap year calculations. Furthermore, Year 2000 compliant information technology, when used in combination with other information technology, shall accurately process date/time data if the other information technology properly exchanges date/time data with it.

OVERDUE PAYMENTS

- a) The Prompt Payment Act, Public Law 97-177 (96 Stat.85, 31 USC 1801) is applicable to payments under this purchase order and requires the payment of contractors of interest on overdue payment and improperly taken discounts.
- b) Determinations of interest due will be made in accordance with the provision of the Prompt Payment Act and Office of Management and Budget Circular A-125.

PAYMENT DUE DATE

- A) Payment under this award will be due on the thirtieth calendar day after the date of actual receipt of a proper invoice in the office designated to receive the invoice or final acceptance of the goods or services, whichever is later.

B) PAYMENT WILL BE MADE VIA ELECTRONIC FUNDS TRANSFER (EFT) TO THE DESIGNATED BANK. BANKING INFORMATION MUST BE PROVIDED SO EFT CAN BE ESTABLISHED. IF THIS INFORMATION IS NOT ON FILE WITH US, PLEASE PROVIDE US WITH THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

INVOICE REQUIREMENTS

Invoices shall be submitted as follows: (1) an original and one copy to the Federal Government office designated on the award document to receive invoices, and (2) one copy to the technical point of contact identified on the order. Unless otherwise specified, this will be the individual identified in the "Ship To"

block on the order. To constitute a proper invoice, the invoice must include the following information and/or attached documentation.

1. Name of the business concern and invoice date.
2. Order number or other authorization for delivery of the goods or services.
3. Description, price, and quantity of goods and services actually delivered or rendered.
4. Shipping and payment terms. Bill of lading number and weight of shipment will be shown for shipments on Government bills of lading. If prepaid, parcel post charges are billed, the gross weight and shipping point must be shown.
5. Other substantiating documentation or information as required by the purchase order.

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
